Professor Emeritus at the University of Geneva, Switzerland. His main research interests cover economic and medical geography, epistemology of social sciences and regional science. In the past years he has focused his works on applied geography, behavioural geography and health care policies. In these fields he has published over 30 books and 300 papers in peer reviewed scientific journals.

He is the member of editorial-advisory board of 15 international journals and has been professor of geography in Canada (Edmonton- Montreal), France (Franche-Comté- Paris), Switzerland (Geneva) and visiting professor in over 40 universities all over the world. He chaired many scientific associations, and among them, the French Speaking Association of Regional Science, the Western Regional Science Association, the Regional Science Association International, the IGU Applied Geography Commission, the Swiss Association of University Professors.

He was awarded the most prestigious prizes in regional science and geography: the «Founders Medal» in 2008 and the «International Vautrin Lud Prize Nobel of Geography» in 2011. He is Doctorate Honoris Causa from the Universities of Québec, Budapest and Lisbon. Chevalier dans l'Ordre du Mérite, he also got an award from the Association of American Geographers and from the Japanese Association fo Regional Science. He was from 2000 till 2015 the chair of Forumsanté Switzerland and scientific chair of the INRA-PSDR programme in France.
